Phrase - group of words doesn't have both a subject and predicate

Clause - group of words that have both a subject and predicate.

① John and I were stuck there. → ind. clause

② on the beach - phrase (prep.)

③ we found shelter on the trees - clause (ind)
w/ phrase

④ after searching - phrase

→ not all subordinating conjunctions will make depend. clauses

After searching, we found the treasure..
↑ Simple sentences
SS SP aff. what?
act D.O.

After we searched for the treasure, [we found it.]
depend clause complex ind. clause

We searched for the treasure, and we found it.
compound!

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
