Direct object - follows an action verb  
(noun/pronoun)  
NOT in a prep phrase  
NOT follow linking verbs

verb w/ d.obj = transitive

He <sup>AV</sup> measured <sup>DO</sup> the distance <sup>P.Phr.</sup> (from my house) <sup>P.Phr.</sup> (to Mike).

indirect object - follows action verb  
has to already be a D.Obj  
"to whom" "for whom"

Because → \* already a "who or what" D.Obj
