- Martha ran boldly through the hall.

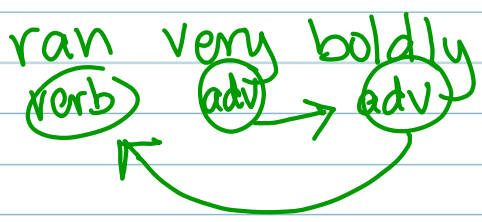

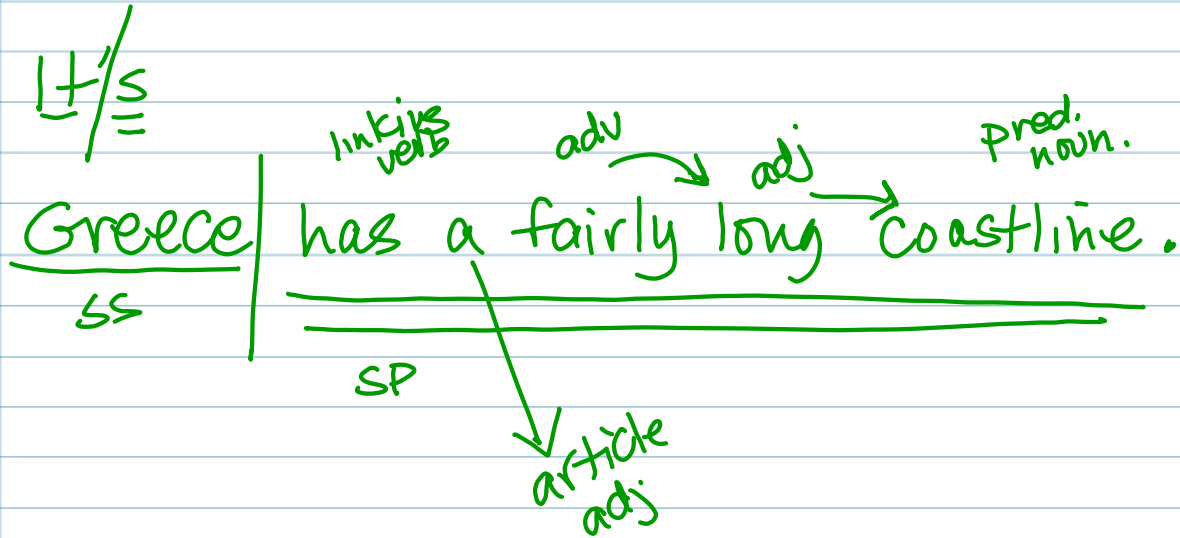
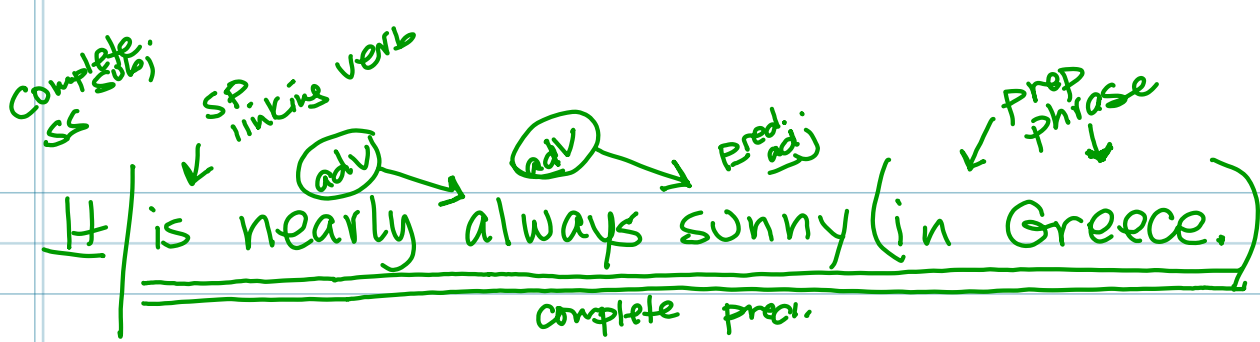
