infinitive - "to" + verb

act like a noun, not the simple predicate
(verb)

don't confuse (to) as preposition
She walked (to the store.)
prep. phrase

phrase - because of me

clause - because the cat was on the couch

phrase - do not have both a subj + pred

clause - have both subj + pred

subordinating conjunction - highlight the phrase or clause that of lesser importance...

coordinating conjunction - combine two/more parts of equal importance.
